Situation

STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BUSINESS

I DEFINITIONS

- (i) In these conditions the following terms have the following meanings unless inconsistent with the context:

“Auctioneers” means Lacy Scott & Knight – Property and Business Consultants LLP, whose registered office address is at 10 Risbygate Street, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP33 3AA

“Host” means iBidder.com or Bidspotter.co.uk – The host website portal for this auction;

“Internet Surcharge” means the surcharge charged to the Purchaser on purchased Lots;

“Conditions” means the standard terms and conditions of business set out in this document;

“Lots” means all or any machinery and other items sold or intended to be sold in accordance with these conditions;

“Purchaser” means a person, firm or Company who purchase any Lot;
